












## Benefits: hours per week







## Benefits: library type







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## Some comparative VT data

### VLA Executive Board recommended minimum starting salary for a library director with a bachelor's degree and DOL certification:

#### \$40,300 = \$19.38/hour plus benefits

Vermont Minimum Wage, 2009	\$8.06	\$16,765
Livable Wage in Vermont, 2009 ** single person, rural	\$16.41	\$34,132
VLA recommended minimum salary, 10/2008 ** not including benefits	\$19.38	\$40,300
Average minimum salary, teacher with a BA, 2006-2007 ** not including benefits	\$19.70	\$31,047
State Employee Librarian B (MLS, no experience), 2008-2009 **beginning salary after probation; not including benefits	\$17.55	\$36,504
ALA recommended minimum salary for beginning librarians, 2008 ** librarians with ALA-MLS	\$20.04	\$41,680

#### Compare to local job descriptions

Generally, jobs should be compared based on standard characteristics including:

- § Knowledge and skill required to do the job
- § Level of communication needed: for example does the person speak for the institution, work directly with decision makers in the community, or work with the public more generally
- § Importance of the decisions required by the job
- § Level of authority
- § Impact of the work accomplished
- § Level of physical demands
- § Type of working conditions
- § Supervisory scope
- § Budget responsibility
