## Compare to local job descriptions

Generally, jobs should be compared based on standard characteristics including:
§ Knowledge and skill required to do the job
§ Level of communication needed: for example does the person speak for the institution, work directly with decision makers in the community, or work with the public more generally
§ Importance of the decisions required by the job
§ Level of authority
§ Impact of the work accomplished
§ Level of physical demands
§ Type of working conditions
§ Supervisory scope
§ Budget responsibility
