

StoryWalk Tip Sheet

Contract for use

Thank you for expressing an interest in the StoryWalk project. The books for this project are designed to be enjoyed by all ages, free and open to the public, and available year round. To best care for the StoryWalk book, please do the following:

- ❖ Identify the party responsible for the care of the book
- ❖ Use a sled or wagon to transport the pages as they are posted
- ❖ Start the hole with a separate stake rather than any of the stakes with pages
- ❖ Usually a light tap is all that is needed to post the page
- ❖ Space the pages apart to draw the reader along the route so they know where to walk
- ❖ Identify community volunteers who will keep an eye on the book, straightening any stakes that fall over and collecting any pages that may have loosened
- ❖ Return the book in the condition it was borrowed – note any damages that need repair – see Cost of Replacement Listing
