[2 existing vacancies] The Board meets quarterly on the second Tuesday of the month in January, April, July and October, 10:00 am-noon. Board meetings are open to the public and we welcome a VLA representative to attend Board meetings. The next meeting will be July 12 at 10:00 a.m. at the Rockingham Free Public Library (geographic naming hearing).
