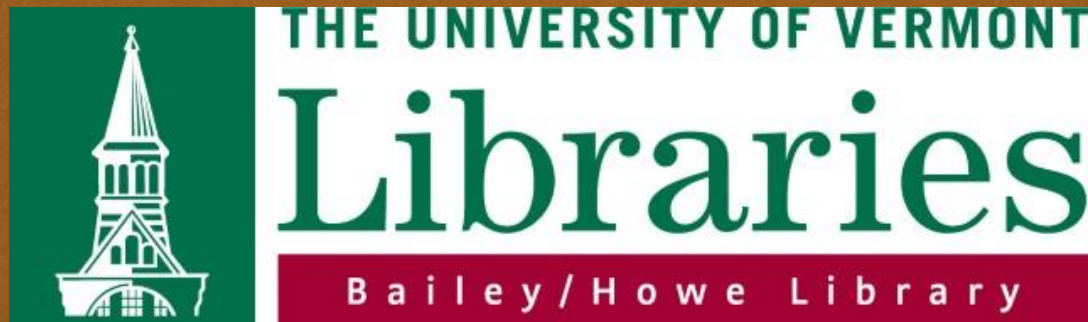


A New Tool for the Instruction Toolbox: *Guide On the Side*

What IS Guide on the Side?



A two-panel system where

In one panel: a student can read information, get direction, or get asked basic comprehension questions

In another panel: A student can perform a task or a directed sequence of tasks

∞ Extending/ Enriching with IL concepts
