VTLIB History with Palace

In 2022 the Vermont Department of Libraries began a new eBook and eAudiobook service with the Palace Project, available to all public libraries in the state and state employees at no cost.



Previously, econtent was offered through RBDigital. The mission and model of the Palace Project and Lyrasis lined up with the goals for a statewide project.

Previous content migrated over to Palace and the collection was refreshed with new content from Baker and Taylor and the Palace Marketplace. Libraries who participate may also buy additional items for their specific patrons.

Palace works synergistically with the great work of the Green Mountain Library Consortium so shared content will populate into the app for participating libraries.



Collection Development



One time ARPA funds provided a portion of initial funding for perpetually licensed items from Baker & Taylor and The Palace Marketplace.

Funding comes from the Institute of Museum and Library Services under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act, administered by the Vermont Department of Libraries.

The collection has been developed to serve as a permanent core collection for the state. The collection consist of eBooks and eAudiobooks for all ages and in multiple languages.

Where possible, we have focused on diverse authors and topics, Vermont award winners, and Vermont-related books.





VTLIB Shared Collection Content Overview

The VT Department of Libraries has purchased a significant number of titles that have been shared with all VT libraries that adopt The Palace Project!

26,121 items are in the shared collection. Some highlights include:

Book Vermont Library

The Book Vermont Library is available to any VT resident or visitor!

- If your library doesn't have Palace yet, they can help patrons sign up for Book VT Library
- Sign up in app for a virtual library card
- Access shared collection materials provided by VTLIB
- Available to seasonal visitors for free





Snapshot of Usage in Vermont

- 18,338 total checkouts in 2023
- 7,646 total checkouts as of April 2024
- Audiobooks are very popular! 77% of checkouts are audio.
- VT libraries are adding an average of 120 new users per month across the state
- 160 Vermont State Employees have used Palace
- Approximately 3,000 total patrons have logged in to Palace

New Palace Features

In the Palace App:

- Search within EPUBs on iOS and Android
- Added audiobook duration to the book details page (when available)
- Changed the forward and rewind buttons from 15 to 30 seconds
- Push notifications
- Language localization on Android

In the Palace Collection Manager:

- Enhanced reporting data dashboard coming soon!
- Added collection item count by format to the Collection Manager dashboard
- Integration with Aspen Discovery Layer
- Support for FOLIO ILS using SIP2 authentication




Focus on Discovery

- Display your backlist selections alongside more recent titles that are "available now"
