



- Awards up to \$1,000
- Cover staff salary, supplies, participant-focused materials, external service providers, etc.
- Engage K-12 individuals

Fund Use Examples

- Purchasing materials needed to facilitate the NASA STEM Kits on STAR Net.
- Inviting presenters & mobile museum workshops from the Montshire Museum of Science.
- Engagement materials to host a NASA downlink, 20-min live call with astronauts aboard the ISS.

Application

- 1. Cover page
- 2. Program narrative
- 3. Description of the library(s) and community served
- 4. Budget detail with narrative and cost-share plan
- 5. If applicable, a signed letter of commitment from external STEM vendors that will be participating in the proposed program
